



Tishomingo County Lands Project Atlas. Dennen Steel, a second tier supplier to Toyota as well as a diversified array of other manufacturers, has selected Tishomingo County for its newest operation. Dennen Steel has plants in Michigan and Indiana. The Mississippi plant will be the company's first foray into the southeastern USA. Tishomingo County and Yellow Creek Port Authority will build the approximately 50,000 SF industrial building on land near Yellow Creek Port purchased by the county from TVA. The funding breakdown follows:

\$2,000,000 CAP loan to county for building to be repaid by company
\$ 750,000 TVA loan to county for building to be repaid by company
\$ 500,000 trust fund grant from Yellow Creek Port for building
\$ 773,000 CDBG grant to county for site work, access, and infrastructure
\$ 173,000 ARC grant to county for site work, access, and infrastructure
\$ 180,060 land purchase by county
\$4,376,060 total state and local investment
